

GOLF CART FLYER

(RE: Title 5, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic",
New Chapter 6, "Non-Highway Vehicles")

On 08-16-2010, the Village of Holiday Hills, Illinois voted to allow certain non-highway vehicles (hereafter referred to as a golf cart, and golf carts only) to drive on certain roads within the village limits. The new ordinance will take effect August 27, 2010. A golf cart is the only non-highway vehicle authorized to be driven on most of the roads of Holiday Hills, Illinois. Your village officials hope you enjoy the use of your golf carts, but stress the importance of safety while operating them as they can be more difficult to see by drivers of other motor vehicles. Each person applying for a Village Vehicle Sticker will be given a copy of this flyer and sign for it acknowledging they are made aware of the rules governing the safe use of the golf carts on the roadways and the requirements to legally operate one in the Village limits. Blank copies of these reports will be in the HHPD report box and in the "Blank Forms" file on the computer.

The RULES OF THE ROAD will be strictly enforced.

1. No golf cart will be authorized to be driven on Vaupell Drive or Vaupell Ave., or anywhere else posted by signs prohibiting such action. (Note: Obviously, this includes River Road as well, as it is posted faster than 35 mph).
2. Permissible golf carts are defined in [625 ILCS 5/1-123.9](#);
3. A person may not operate a golf cart upon any street or roadway in the Village unless he or she has a valid Illinois driver's license issued in his or her name by the Illinois Secretary of State and the [driver is a minimum of 18 years of age](#).
4. No golf cart may be driven on any street or roadway in the Village of Holiday Hills, Illinois unless a current, valid Village of Holiday Hills [Vehicle Sticker is visibly displayed](#) on such authorized golf cart as required by local ordinance Chapter 5, "Vehicle Stickers", of this Village Code; and the vehicle [shall be subject to the mandatory insurance requirements](#) under the Illinois Motor Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5), as required by state and local statute, which [will be provided and shown at the time of purchasing the Vehicle Sticker](#). They will also provide proof (make a copy). They will be required to carry a copy on their golf cart while operating, as insurance is normally only good for 6 months at a time.
5. A golf cart may be operated within the Village only on streets where the posted speed limit is 35 miles per hour or less, but this does not prohibit a golf cart from crossing a road or street at an intersection where the road or street has a posted speed limit of more than 35 miles per hour. [All the streets in Holiday Hills, IL have a posted 20 mph speed limit \(except River Rd.\)](#), so no authorized golf cart may be operated on a Village roadway at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour.
